<b>6.1</b>	<p><b>NYM/2020/0075/FL – Spring House Farm, Clay Bank, Gt Broughton</b>  For amalgamation of dwelling and holiday cottage/annexe accommodation to form single residential unit for local occupancy letting/holiday letting use or as annexe accommodation. (no external alterations)  The Parish Council resolved no objection</p>
<b>6.2</b>	<p><b>NYM/2020/0124/FL – Brackenburn, Ingleby Greenhow</b>  For construction of extensions and alterations to dwelling and garage.  The Parish Council resolved no objection</p>
<b>6.3</b>	<p><b>NYM/2020/0121/FL Stone Stoup, Stone Stoup hill, Ingleby Greenhow</b>  For construction of single storey and first floor extension.  The Parish Council resolved no objection, but requested neighbours comment be taken into account.</p>
<b>6.4</b>	<p><b>APPLICATIONS MADE TO HDC (for consultation)</b>  <b>Rose Cottage, Ingleby Greenhow (The Camping and Caravaning Club)</b>  Application to operate a certified exempted camping and caravan site.  The Parish Council are requested to comment on application, to the Caravan and Camping Club who issues the license rather than HDC who are also consulted.  It was noted that this was the third such type of application made in the Parish in the last year.  A number of concerns were expressed by residents. In the main these related to the unsuitability of the site as a Caravan and Camping site.  The Chairman recommended that the residents should write their concerns to The Caravan Club and NYMNPA can to copy in HDC.  The Parish Council resolved to write Caravan and Camping Club and object to the</p>

When the beck is in flood the water backs upto the drain. It thought it is the landowner responsibility to clean the drain out.
