4	<p>OPEN FORUM Battersby Junction Community Association Recreation Area. Caryn Loftus gave a presentation and update on the recreation play area at Battersby Junction. A 'Reaching Communities National Lottery' grant was awarded in 2019 and used to create a recreation area for all ages including a safe area with play equipment seating and tree planting also establishing links with the local school and attracting visitors to the area. The Parish Council passed on their thanks and congratulations to Caryn and the Battersby Junction Community Association Recreation Area Team on their dedication and hard work in creating such a fantastic play area. The Parish Council Resolved to agree to contribute to the annual insurance cost of the area up to £1000. This would start in 2023.</p>

The above application was looked at the NYMNPA planning committee meeting Thursday 14th October. The Parish Council resolved to comment again about the concerns regarding the water issues in Old Battersby.</p>
8	<p>PARISH COUNCIL REPORT ON ACTIONS FROM PREVIOUS MEETINGS</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Broadband Old Battersby Ongoing. 2. Ingleby Greenhow ownership of Pound area. The local History group are still looking into this. 3. Parish Boundary Stones. Near to the Water Beck turn off, from the Clay Bank road a boundary stone has been located. It is still standing but needs cleaning to be readable. 4. Notice board Battersby Junction. One quote received Parish Clerk to seek another one. 5. Defibrillator Training. This will take place on Tuesday 16th November at 1.45 and 6pm in Ingleby Greenhow and Easby Village Hall. 6. St Andrew Churchyard Some work is being done on the footpath which run through the Churchyard to Church Lane. The Parish Council gave money to the IGPC for the upkeep of the church yard. It was agreed for Chair to speak to the IG-PCC about the upkeep of the churchyard.

10	<p>NYCC COUNCILLOR REPORT</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Water Beck Road has been reported and it is on the list for next year. 2. Road Surface Atkinsons Wood Farm to the junction to Old Battersby complaint received about the road surface. NYCC Cllr H Moorhouse informed the meeting engineers

	<p>have advised that this section of road was not included in the surface dressing program as it is not suitable for this treatment. It is not unsafe, so unlikely to trigger anything more extensive in the near future. However, all roads across the district are subject to a 'scrim' survey which will identify if the road has sufficient anti-skid levels and if not they will look at other possible treatments.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 3. Signpost on the Junction of Ingleby Greenhow, Gt Broughton to Chopgate. This was damaged several years ago, and the Parish Council have asked for a new one in the past 4. Lamb Lane edge of road is crumbling on the left. 5. Countdown markers missing on the Gt Broughton Road. <p>Cllr H Moorhouse agreed to investigate the above.</p>
