Site visit has been inspected by Highways Officer who advises that they could not identify any flooding. NYCC advice they have no funding that would allow for any drainage improvement. It was agreed that photos to be taken when flooding occurs in this area. 4. Ingleby Bank Flooding from Forestry onto the road. - Clerk had written to Forestry England Head office advice to write to the Pickering office.

Clay Bank to Beck House, School Bank and near to St Andrew Church Ingleby Greenhow. - Section of roads still waiting to be surface dressed. 7. Bank Foot Road -Gully near to the entrance of first field on right gully been checked and is now added to NYCC list for annual cleaning. 8. Bank Foot Farm – Two gully have now been cleaned and added to NYCC list for annual clean. 9. Bank Foot Road verge area - Cllr R Hudson to hold a site meeting with NYCC Highways to identify for areas. 10. Holly Tree Corner Lamb Lane – Cllr H Moorhouse would check to see if this is on the annual cleaned. 11. Reporting on the NYCC Highways Portal – The Parish Council felt that this is not satisfactory as you receive an email acknowledging the request however no further updates as to action. 12.
