He believed involved a Forest England contract stalker, above Bank Foot on Forest England land when a deer was shot between the Turkey Nab unsurfaced highway and the forest road barrier towards the water plant, only a few meters from the road. Cllr T Sutcliffe informed the Parish Council that he contacted the Forestry England Area Manager to raise this issue as a safety concern. Cllr Staples stated that the was also aware of the issue.</p>
